2.32.010 Duty to Conduct Suits--Defend City. In addition to the duties of the City Attorney, as now prescribed by law, he shall appear in all courts and conduct all suits, either at law or in equity, in which the City is either the complainant or the defendant; and he shall prepare all informations and complaints against all persons charged with violating any of the ordinances of the City of Snohomish and he shall appear before the court having jurisdiction of the offense charged and conduct the prosecution of said cause on the part of the City. 2.32.020 Appeal Cases. In all cases appealed, whether civil or criminal, the City Attorney shall appear and represent said city before the appellate court and prosecute or defend the action as the case may demand, before said court. -(Ord. 97, 1893).

2.32.030 Preparing Ordinances, Contracts--Attending Council Meetings. It shall be the duty of the City Attorney to prepare all ordinances as well as all conveyances, contracts, and bonds to which the City may be a party; to prepare all notices which the law or ordinances require the city to make and publish; to attend all regular and special meetings of the City Council and do and perform all such other duties as are required of him by the ordinances of the City and the laws of the State of Washington.
