The minutes from May 27<sup>th</sup> were approved as presented.

Todd Elvig presented a couple of designs for the 150<sup>th</sup> logo and the committee members selected the design below as the official logo:



Fundraising committee reported that they will have a booth at Kla Ha Ya Days that will have a balloon pop game with prizes from Snohomish businesses. A request for start up funds will be presented to the Historic Downtown Snohomish on July 1<sup>st</sup>. Committee members were asked to volunteer some time to staff the booth. The committee is also working on a Progressive Dinner. The concept of a Snohomish Community Foundation was discussed and Debbie will set a meeting with the Greater Everett Foundation to understand how that might work.

The commemorative coins were discussed and how to best market them. The fundraising committee will meet on July 1<sup>st</sup> at 4pm to discuss further. Todd shared some industry related designs that could be used for the back side of the coin. It was also discussed that we could create postage stamps from the logo and that some postage meters can be programmed to print special messages.

Other fundraising ideas that were discussed were asking for donations of trees in honor of the 150<sup>th</sup> and then planting them in designated places in the City.

The Committee established the following monthly themes for 2009:

January – Founding Families	July – Kla Ha Ya
February – Native Culture	August – Sports History
March – Early Industry	September – Architecture
April – Natural Environment and Sustainability	October – Fall Festival
May – Authors and Literature	November – Service to Our Country
June – Arts	December – Our Future

The History Education committee reported that as a part of the display that they will be placing at the Waltz Building during Kla Ha Ya Days next year it will tie in the collection of Snohomish High School class graduation pictures from the Historical Society.
