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City of Snohomish Fee Schedule

Section 1: General Provisions

- 1.1 Definitions: For the purpose of this resolution and the administration of fees, rates, and charges, the following definitions shall apply:
- a. “Associate” user is a group that has shown responsible facility usage for at least three facility use events, has a group coordinator that has shown a record of responsible cleanup and lockup, and provides a level of cleanup above and beyond the condition of the facility prior to the event (such as extra mopping, dusting, wiping).
 - b. “Local” user is a group whose coordinator or assigned member is a citizen of the City of Snohomish or whose group is associated with a Snohomish civic organization.
 - c. “Non local” user is a group whose coordinator or assigned member is not a citizen of the City of Snohomish or whose group is non associated with a Snohomish civic organization.
 - d. “Permit Fee” means the total sum of the fees specified herein for a specified scope of work. For example, where the Fee Schedule specifies a base fee and a fee for specific equipment, fixtures, or decisions, the permit fee shall be the sum of those applicable fees.

- 2.2 Transfer of License: The administrative fee to transfer a license from one location to another within the City shall be \$10.00.
- 2.3 Late Payment Fee: The business license application together with the tendered fee shall be submitted to the City Clerk 30 days prior to a business engaging in its first business transaction within the City. Annual renewals shall be submitted by application and fee no later than the last day of month of license expiration. A \$10.00 per month late charge shall be imposed for each month after the license expiration.

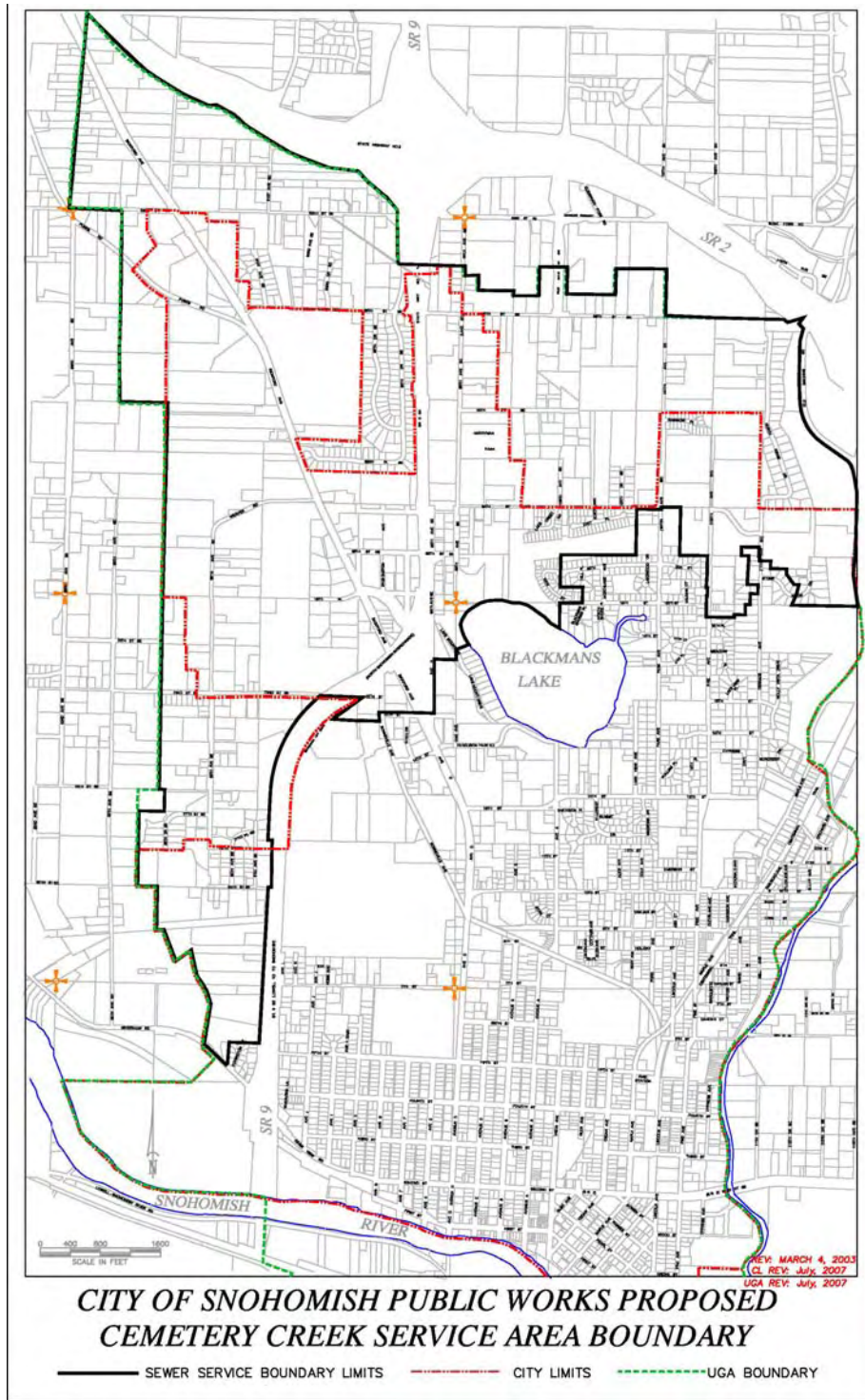
