CENTENNIAL TRAIL EXTENSION

Construction Update

August 19, 2011

CONSTRUCTION BEGINS!

The City of Snohomish is pleased to notify you that construction of the Centennial Trail Extension will begin the week of August 22, 2011. Work will extend about 2/3 of a mile from the existing trail at Bowen Avenue to the south side of the Maple/Pine intersection. It is scheduled to be completed by December. You can learn more about the trail project at www.ci.snohomish.wa.us/Parks

Work is scheduled to begin on Monday, August 22, beginning with survey, erosion control and removal of the railroad ties and rails. The general contractor, Strider Construction Co., Inc., will begin bringing equipment and materials to the trail corridor this same week.

Construction unavoidably brings noise, dust, truck traffic, and other temporary inconveniences. When the dust settles, you should see a new park and trail that we invite you to enjoy.

Beginning Wednesday, August 24th, each resident will need to make sure that all vehicles and other personal property are removed from the following areas between 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM:

- Trail property, including Senior Center gravel parking.
 - West side of Lincoln between 3rd and 5th Streets. All vehicles must be parked on the east side of Lincoln Avenue or on private property.
 - Trail crossing areas on Bowen, Second, Third, Fourth and Sixth.
- Vehicles left in the work area during these construction hours will be towed by the Contractor. Additionally, any items left by residents in the construction area will be removed by the Contractor.
