

**Volunteers Sought for TBD
Ballot Statement Committees**

The City of Snohomish Transportation Benefit District Board is interested in hearing from citizens want to volunteer to be members of committees to develop arguments both in favor and in opposition to a ballot measure being considered by the Board

The ballot measure being considered by the TBD Board would allow voters to decide the question of whether a 0.2% increase in sales tax should be implemented within the city to fund certain street improvements and street maintenance work.

The TBD Board is responsible under state law to appoint both pro and con committees that would draft language for the Voters Pamphlet. By state law, the committees are limited to three citizens each. However, the committees may draw on the expertise of others in developing their ballot statements.

Committee members are sought from the Snohomish area but are not required to be residents or property owners within the city limits.
